The business quickly grew, as the demand for quality loose leaf teas became apparent. The Art of Tea now has over 130 tea & herbal varieties available! The stall at Salamanca Market still plays a key part in the success of the business with interstate & overseas visitors returning to the stall for more of their favourite tea blends. The locals visit often too for a chat and to stock up on their favourite teas.

The Art of Tea is also a supplier of uniquely packaged, quality loose leaf tea to cafes, restaurants, providores, & hamper businesses Australia wide. In addition, the online shop commenced in 2004, providing easy shopping for tea lovers across Australia.

In late 2009, the Art of Tea set up a small retail shop at the new warehouse in Kingston. We can be visited there Monday-Friday 9-5:00pm for direct door sales. With free and easy parking directly out the front, it is a great place for locals to shop for gifts and for themselves.

In September 2016 we proudly opened our first “proper” retail shop. The Bouteaque, at 52 Sandy Bay Road Battery Point is a gorgeous retail shop to provide for locals and tourists alike. The range of tea wares is absolutely delightful and we know this will be a busy tea haven!

The Art of Tea now employs 8 people and is committed to the growth of our local economy by employing locals, choosing local business as providers and supporting local businesses with their individual tea needs. In 2014, a new Wholesale Marketing position was created for one of the long term employees, who loves to be out on the road and discuss business needs directly with café, and restaurant food and beverage managers.

At the Art of Tea, we are all passionate about improving health and wellbeing. As such we seek the highest quality ingredients for all our herbal range, as well as our black and green teas. Also, the Rooibos (South African red bush) packed with 37 antioxidants, low tannins and naturally caffeine free has extensive health benefits, and we endeavour to encourage our customers to include this in their selection too.
